How to enable notification through browser?

To receive notifications from your browse, you will need to allow for push notifications, here is a guide for Chrome, Edge, Opera, and Firefox:

For Chrome

1. Click on the three-dotted menu; located at the top righthand corner.
2. Click on Settings.
3. Search for Notifications
4. Follow the yellow indicator to land on the Notifications page.
5. For default behavior, select "Sites can ask to send notifications"
6. Scroll to the "Allowed to send notifications" and click on the "Add" button.
7. Enter wakelet.com into the text box and hit save.

For Edge

1. Click on the three-dotted menu; located at the top righthand corner
2. Click on Settings.
